Choose one of the following topics and write a 4 paragraph essay in MLA format, may be typed or handwritten.

Essay Topic 2 - One of the topics Where the Red Fern Grows address is the contrast between town and rural life. Discuss what the novel has to say about this topic. Cite several specific examples from the novel to support your ideas
