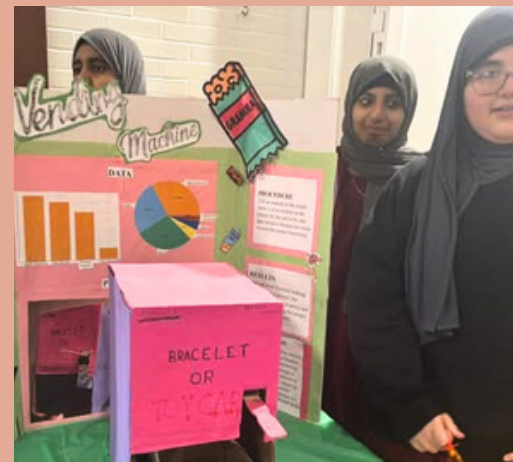
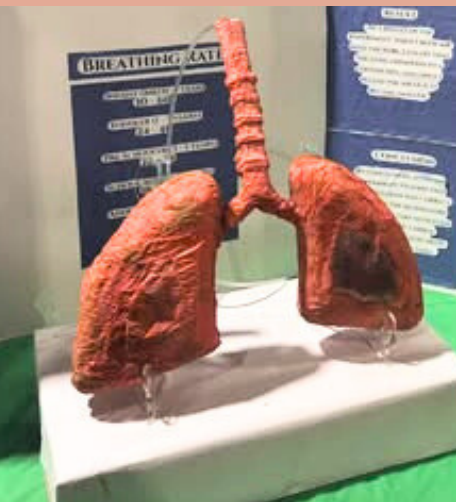

Projects Presented by Middle School and Ninth Grade Students.

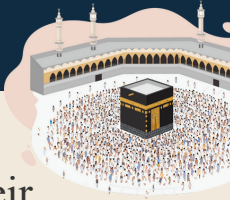


Arabic Week
